**...2 Dear friends, we are already God's children, but he has not yet shown us what we will be like when Christ appears. But we do know that we will be like him, for we will see him as he really is. 3 And all who have this eager expectation will keep themselves pure, just as he is pure.**

## **2 Timothy 1:3-7**



**3 Timothy, I thank God for you—the God I serve with a clear conscience, just as my ancestors did. Night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers...**



## **2 Timothy 1:3-7 cont'd**



**...4 I long to see you again, for I remember your tears as we parted. And I will be filled with joy when we are together again...**



## **2 Timothy 1:3-7 cont'd**



**...5 I remember your genuine faith, for you share the faith that first filled your grandmother Lois and your mother, Eunice. And I know that same faith continues strong in you...**



## 2 Timothy 1:3-7 cont'd



**...6 This is why I remind you to fan into flames the spiritual gift God gave you when I laid my hands on you. 7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline.**

## Romans 8:31-39




**<sup>31</sup> What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? <sup>32</sup> Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else?...**




## Romans 8:31-39 cont'd



**33 ...Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for his own? No one—for God himself has given us right standing with himself. 34 Who then will condemn us? No one—for Christ Jesus died for us and was raised to life for us, and he is sitting in the place of honor at God's right hand, pleading for us...**



## Romans 8:31-39 cont'd



**35 ...Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death?...**



## Romans 8:31-39 cont'd



<sup>36</sup> ...**(As the Scriptures say, “For your sake we are killed every day; we are being slaughtered like sheep.”)** <sup>37</sup> **No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us...**



## Romans 8:31-39 cont'd



**38 ...And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love...**



## Romans 8:31-39 cont'd



**39 ...No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.**
