FINAL EXAM

The final exam is to submit a 3 page, type written paper that answers the following question:

“What is the true mission of the Church today based on the History of the Early Church from our studies?”

All papers must be typed and double-spaced. They need to be three pages, not 2 pages and not 4 pages. If you do not have access to a computer or typewriter, then I will accept an 8 page hand-written paper done in ink. It must also be double spaced meaning there must be a blank line between each line you write. If you do it in pencil, it will not be accepted! You should use your Bible and your knowledge of this class and what you have learned about the History of the Early Church. You can use your notes but do not use other commentaries or resources other than what was used in class.

The two previous projects submitted for this course are credit/no credit each worth 10 points toward your final grade. If you turned them in on time and complete then you have no worries but if you turned neither in or if they were incomplete, then the best you can score is 80 points on the final.
